

Modern Blockade Runners







Heritage Award Medal

The Heritage Award Medal is presented to one camp member who has demonstrated dedication to the Cause by actively promoting the truth about the SCV in his local community. The medal is awarded annually at the National SCV Reunion. Under the current procedure, each camp may appoint one individual who meets the stated requirements as noted on the SCV website. The purpose of this medal is to recognize camp members who act as activists by taking public actions, such as setting up displays at gun shows and emailing information about camp activities to various local community, civic, and political leaders. Many camps find it difficult to identify one among the numerous activist camp members. This has resulted in many camps omitting the selection of a member to receive this national award. Therefore, we will have a new selection process in place after the 2025 Reunion.

We will discuss the new procedure during the Heritage Luncheon at the Houston Reunion. The new criteria will allow camps to select up to three members to nominate. The camp will need to provide documentation of the nominee's activities, such as attending gun shows, sending emails to local community leaders, participating in One Click Politics, or attending a CL Training Session. The next CL Training will be held at the National SCV HQ in Elm Springs, Columbia, TN, on September 6th.



A beta test was conducted on a form placed on the KennedyTwins website. Dean is now working on a similar form so that the data collected can be easily poured into a database. Once completed, this will make it easy for the National SCV to issue news releases directly to friendly newspapers, podcasters, talk radio hosts, etc. We are planning to roll it out at the National Reunion in Houston.

If you would like for your local newspaper, radio, or podcaster to broadcast important news about the SCV and our Southern Heritage, join the CL when we begin using the new form. It will be posted on the CL website, and you will be able to fill in the required data, hit send, and your data will be collected and used with the next news release. With your support we will be able to do an endrun around the mainline media's censorship of all things positive about our South. Once we establish the SCV with friendly local media we will then be able to gain access to national media.
