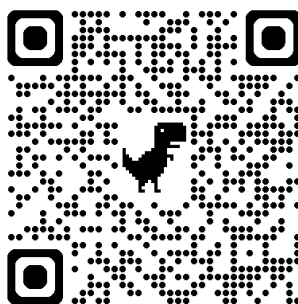

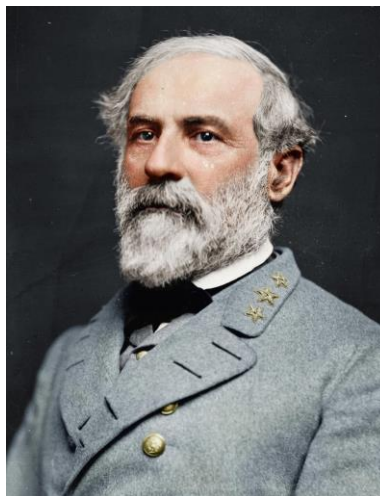

The South: 250 Years after the Declaration of Independence

DoubleTree by Hilton, Raleigh-Durham Airport, Durham, NC.

In 2026, the United States will be celebrating the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. When the South acted upon the principles announced in that document, Yankees responded with invasion, conquest, and subjugation. Mark your calendar for February 28th when our speakers discuss the following topics:

Dr. Thomas J. DiLorenzo will discuss 'Lincoln and those 'Unalienable Rights.' Dr. DiLorenzo is best known for his book, *The Real Lincoln*, which exposes the Lincoln myth. DiLorenzo is President of the Ludwig von Mises Institute in Auburn, AL. He is a former professor of economics at Loyola University Maryland and a longtime member of the senior faculty of the Mises Institute.

Dr. Jeffery F. Addicott will discuss 'Trampling on the Declaration.' Dr. Addicott is a professor of Law and the Director of the Warrior Defense Project at St. Mary's University School of Law, San Antonio, Texas. Dr. Addicott has written several books on Union terrorism, such as *Trampling Union Terror*. He is an internationally recognized authority on terrorism and the law of war.

Dr. Wanjiru Njoya will discuss 'Marxism, Cultural Revolution, and the South.' Dr. Njoya is a native of Kenya and earned her Ph.D. in Law from the University of Cambridge (UK), where she was a Rhodes Scholar at St. Edmund's College. Dr. Njoya currently works as the Walter D. Williams Research Fellow at Ludwig von Mises Institute, a free-market think tank, in Auburn, Alabama.

James R. (Ron) Kennedy will discuss 'Reconstruction and the death of the Declaration.' Ron is the co-author of *The South Was Right!* and over twenty other books about Southern history and limited Constitutional government. In *Reconstruction, Destroying the Republic and Creating an Empire*, the author demonstrates the North's attack upon the Declaration of Independence. Ron holds an M.A. from Tulane and an M.J. from Loyola University.

Walter D. (Donnie) Kennedy will discuss 'The Genesis of the Declaration of Independence.' Donnie is the author and co-author of 16 books on Southern history and limited government. Donnie currently serves as the Commander-in-Chief of the Sons of Confederate Veterans.

Paul C. Graham will serve as the Master of Ceremonies for this year's S. D. Lee's lectures. Paul, the author of several books on Southern history, such as *Non Sense on Stilts: The Gettysburg Address & Lincoln*. Paul is co-founder, co-owner, and Managing Director of Shotwell Publishing and is currently the SCV's Chief of Heritage Operations. He holds an M.A. in Philosophy from the University of South Carolina. He has appeared on CBS Nightly News, AP, NPR, and the BBC as a spokesman for Southern Rights.

Heritage Promotions Medal Procedure

Purpose:

The purpose of the Heritage Promotion Medal is to encourage individual camp members to become actively involved in local Heritage Promotion activities and to recognize said members for their dedicated efforts to vindicate the Cause in their local community.

Camp Responsibilities:

1. Camp uses the attached form to document members who, within the prior 12 months, have met the requirements for the Heritage Promotion Award. Individuals who have previously received a Heritage Promotion Medal and are appointed again will receive a gold star to affix to the ribbon on their medal. Up to five stars may be awarded to the individual.
2. The camp Commander or his designee will complete the Heritage Promotion Award attestation and email/mail it to the Chief of Heritage Operations no later than April 15. [See attestation on the following page]
3. The Chief of Heritage Operations will send copies of attestations to National Headquarters by May 15th.

Step One:

To Receive the Heritage Award, the Member:

- a. Must be a member in good standing of the SCV and earn a minimum of 12 points,
- b. Participated in one or more of the One Click Politics sent out by the National SCV, [3 points]
- c. Sent two or more emails regarding the camp's Heritage Promotion activities to local agents of influence (local community leaders, church leaders, and local media), such as cleaning the grave site of a local veteran of any war, a photo of the SCV billboard, or giving our Dixie Defenders a local festival or gun show. [3 points]
- d. Sent two or more emails (or snail mail) to local elected or state officials [3 points]
- e. Participated in camp display at Gun Show or local festival [3]
- f. Sent to National HQ information regarding local actual or potentially friendly media [2 points]
- g. Attended Confederate Legion training session [3 points]
- h. Joined or renewed CL membership [3 points]
- i. Other as specified by camp commander/designee, number 8 on form [2 points]

Step Two:

The camp Commander or his designee reviews the individual's activities and signs the form attesting that, to the best of his knowledge, all the activities listed are true. Email (preferred) or mail form to the Chief of Heritage Operations.
